

**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**POSEYVILLE TOWN COUNCIL**

***Date of Meeting: Monday, March 18, 2024***

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by Town Council President Justin Rutledge at 7:00 PM

**PRESENT:** Justin Rutledge, Mike Baehl, and Jodie Rankin

Virtual Attendee's: None

Meeting called for Awarding of Cemetery Bid/ Mowing Bid.

Justin asked if anyone needed to see the hard copies. Mike stated that as long as all were scanned in, he was okay. Justin stated that they were all scanned in.

Justin stated that the low bid was from A Cut Above Landscape Solutions for \$600.00 per mowing. The next lowest was roughly \$763.00 per mowing.

Justin asked if there were any questions. Mike asked if in the \$600.00 per mowing quote, was the Northside next to Main St. included in that. Mike said where the wartime monuments are located. Justin and Jodie agreed that this spot was included. Justin stated that this covered the corner of Main St and 165 all the way to Pine St. Mike wanted to make sure that that was put in the bid. Justin showed Mike the Bid Proposal where it states "Poseyville Cemetery corner of Main Street and 165 to Pine Street." Justin and Jodie agreed that it was put in as part of bid.

Jodie stated that she did also check into the company and they do have 2 other cemetery contracts. Jodie verified and these other contracts stated they do a really good job. Jodie stated she was concerned about that and she just wanted to double check to make sure.

Justin stated that this company is the sole provider for 3 local cemeteries in the Poseyville area for 4 years. Justin also stated that they did already submit a certificate of insurance already as well.

**Mike made a motion to accept A Cut Above Landscape Solutions bid to do the mowing at the Poseyville Cemetery and to start as soon as possible and not wait until April 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jodie Rankin.**

Justin asked if there was anymore to discuss. Mike wanted to know if we should meet with them and walk through the cemetery and maybe take pictures. That way if someone complains that their headstone was hit or anything. Mike was just wondering if it would be a good idea or not and stated that he was not sure if the this would be a concern of the companies or not. Justin stated if nothing else he could walk up there and video it all, to have something, to show if there is/was already damage or if there was no damage at all. Mike stated this would help some to protect the company. Mike said we have not done this before but thought maybe this would be helpful. Justin stated when he would contact them to let them know, he would ask if this is something they are interested in. Jodie stated they might do that their first time through but she was not

sure. Jodie stated they have done 3 cemeteries so that may be something that they already do. The council all agreed that it would be something worth asking.



**With a motion made by Justin Rutledge and 2nd by Mike Baehl the meeting was adjourned.**


