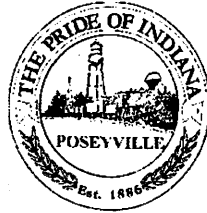
Consideration by the Town of Poseyville of the Posey County Unified Development Ordinances after hearing the first reading on March 10, 2026.

Justin Rutledge seconded the motion.


